

Expressway in S.C. gains key approval

A section of a planned \$2 billion expressway in South Carolina has gained key approval.

State and federal officials signed the final environmental impact statement for the northern leg of the proposed Interstate 73 on Wednesday. The southern leg of the highway already has gained final approval.

Officials expect to clear a final step in October.

The entire expressway will run about 90 miles in South Carolina and eventually link Myrtle Beach with Michigan.
