

Mixed-use rezoning request to be heard

The county planning board will hear a request tonight that would allow a mixed-use development to be built on N.C. 68 at Edgefield Road.

The Guilford County Planning Board is scheduled to hear a rezoning request tonight that would allow a mixed-use development to be built on N.C. 68 at Edgefield Road. The proposed 66-acre development would permit a multifamily residential neighborhood with up to 274 units to be built on the property. It would also allow a corporate park with up to 275,000 square feet of space and as much as 200,000 square feet of retail space.

The case was brought before the board in June, but was continued after nearby residents requested more time to meet with the developer over concerns they had about the development and its impact on them. It was also continued in July after planning board members said they wanted to know a more information from the DOT on the route of I-73 in the area.

The meeting will be held tonight at 7 p.m. at the Old County Courthouse in downtown Greensboro.
