

Mich. to Myrtle Beach: Portion of Interstate 73 gets final OK

MYRTLE BEACH, S.C. (AP) — State officials can begin buying land for a new interstate that will one day connect Myrtle Beach with Michigan.

U.S. Deputy Transportation Secretary Thomas J. Barrett was in Myrtle Beach on Friday to sign the final document. It gives the go-ahead for the portion of Interstate 73 that will connect Myrtle Beach with Interstate 95.

Federal officials also have given the state permission to use tolls on the interstate to help pay for it.
