Proposed interstate project moves forward

The proposed Interstate 73, which would connect Myrtle Beach to Michigan, was the first of three projects accepted into a federal pilot program that would allow private companies to toll the road to repay construction costs, the state Transportation Department learned Friday.

Tyler Duvall, assistant secretary for policy at the U.S. Department of Transportation, said tolls make it more likely the \$2.3 billion road will be constructed.
