

Section of Greensboro loop road to open Tuesday

RALEIGH - A 4.3-mile section of the Greensboro Western Loop is scheduled to open Tuesday, and will stretch from I-40 west of Guilford College Road to north of Bryan Boulevard. The stretch will feature exits at I-40, Friendly Avenue and Bryan Boulevard. The road is designated as Future I-73/840. Construction on the \$101.6 million contract began in September 2003.

An additional 7.7 miles of the western loop, designated as I-40, are scheduled to open early next year, weather permitting, and will stretch from I-85 near Groometown Road to I-40 west of Guilford Road.
